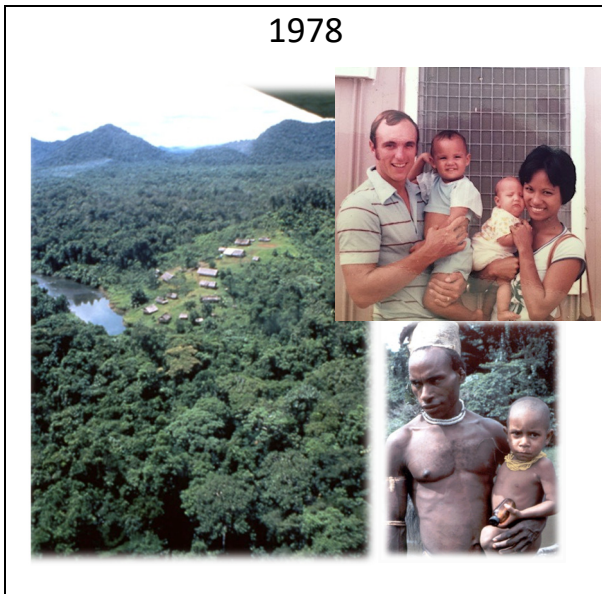

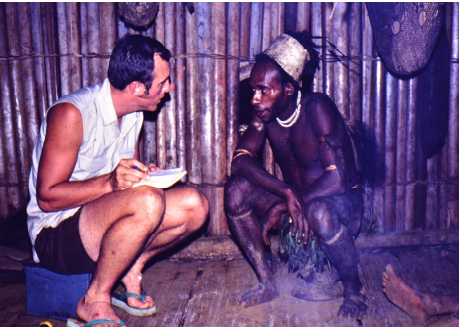

The Character of God

- His Holiness
